NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

**1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

Nature of Activities

AgriSafe Network, Inc. is a national membership organization representing rural-based hospitals, health clinics, and county health departments that provides preventative occupational health services for the farming community.

Basis of Accounting

The accompanying financial statement has been prepared on the basis of accounting used for income tax reporting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other than generally accepted accounting principles. Revenue is recognized when received rather than when earned, and expenses are recognized when paid rather than when the obligation is incurred.

Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the income tax basis of accounting requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures. Accordingly, actual results could differ from those estimates.

Support and Revenue

AgriSafe Network, Inc. receives its grant and contract support primarily from businesses associated with agriculture, foundations, and Iowa's Center for Agricultural Safety and Health. AgriSafe Network, Inc. received 94% of their support from two organizations.

Income Taxes

AgriSafe Network, Inc. is exempt from federal income taxes under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and did not conduct unrelated business activities. Therefore, AgriSafe Network, Inc. has made no provision for federal income taxes in the accompanying financial statements. AgriSafe Network, Inc. has also been classified as an entity that is not a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a) and qualifies for deductible contributions as provided in Section 170(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Concentration of Credit Risk

At December 31, 2005, AgriSafe Network, Inc. had bank deposits of \$31,477 in excess of federally insured limits.
