**Minimum Educational Standards to be  
Designated an AgriSafe Provider**

In addition to following the requirements outlined in the affiliation agreement, a person qualifies to be an AgriSafe Provider member if they meet the following educational standards:

A nurse (at least at the RN level), nurse practitioner, physician assistant, physician (MD, ND, or DO) or chiropractor (DC) may be an AgriSafe Provider member if they meet the requirements outlined in the affiliation agreement. Professionals who meet these educational standards must be directly involved in the provision of AgriSafe services. They may arrange for other health care providers to provide a portion of the AgriSafe services. However, the review of the farmer's occupational history form and the education that would follow must be done by the professional (nurse, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, physician (MD, ND, or DO) or chiropractor(DC) who has attended an AgriSafe Approved Agricultural Occupational Health training, maintained the required CEUs and follows the affiliation agreement.
