Calling All Community Health Workers: AgriSafe is Offering Free CEU's Through Nov. 1, 2025

Covington, LA – AgriSafe Network was recently awarded grant funding from the Network of the National Library of Medicine (NNLM) Region 3 of the National Institutes of Health to support training and Continuing Education Units (CEUs) for Community Health Workers (CHWs), Promotores de Salud, and Community Health Worker-Instructors (CHW-Is) across the U.S. through the November 1st. CHWs help to forge connections where people live, work, worship, and heal, promoting positive rural health outcomes through outreach, education, and support. AgriSafe is proud to offer education on topics not typically covered in CHW training programs, regarding agricultural health and safety.

The specific training topics AgriSafe is offering include:

- Mental Health in Agricultural Communities
- Suicide Prevention
- Personal Protective Equipment
- Heat-related illnesses
- Zoonotic Disease
- Sleep
- Vaccinations

CHW and CHW-I CEUs for these courses, created by AgriSafe, are available through collaboration with the University of Texas at Tyler Health Science Center, Center for Community & Rural Health Education.
